Hairspray

What's the Story?

In 1960s Baltimore, dance-loving teen Tracey Turnblad auditions for a spot on 'The Corney Collins Show' and wins. becomes an overnight celebrity, a trendsetter in dance, fun and fashion. Perhaps her new status as a teen sensation is enough to topple Corney's reigning dance queen and bring integration to the show.



Art

- Hairspray is set in the 1960's when the Pop Art movement was at its peak. Watch Tuesdays video tutorial on how to make a pop art inspired collage.
- Create a Hairspray silhouette (right). Ask an adult or friend to draw around your outline, adding any details in after. Using old magazines, cut out the letters for 'Hairspray' or perhaps you name.



Drama

- Create a freeze frame of a BLM protest.
- Can you create good and bad points about the protest?
- There are 2 sides to the protest, for and against. Split in to the 2 groups and discuss what might be said, then swap over. Can you think of something different?
- Like Panto Dames, Tracy's Mum is played by a man. Use the internet/imagination to create your own Dame. In pairs get some paper and describe your Dame to your partner while they draw, then swap.

Music

- Hairspray has a range of emotive songs. There are songs about being happy, sad, in love, angry etc. Can you think of some songs you know which make you feel happy, sad etc?
- Hairspray is also about equal rights. What do you think needs to be improved in the world?

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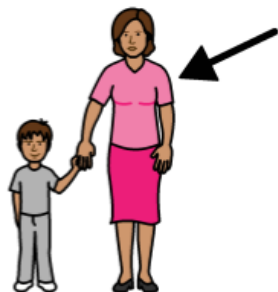

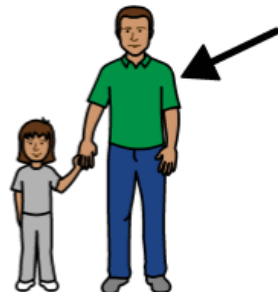

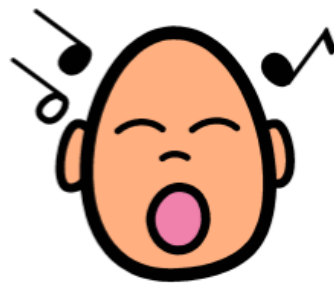
