Pathway: Explore

Qualification: Entry Pathways (Level 2/3)

Course outline:

Explore pathway classes have the chance to study Humanities in Year 10 and Year 11. Lessons are taught in form groups with different abilities being catered for within lessons. Pupils will study towards either an Entry Level 2 or 3 in Humanities.

Humanities is the study of the world and combines Geography, History and Religious Studies as well as some aspects of Citizenship and even French. Students develop their knowledge and skills in all of these areas with the main focus of skills being around Geography and History. Pupils will also get the chance to study specific countries and people from the past and present.

Assessment:

Students work towards providing evidence against Assessment Criteria for a range of units. Pupils will need a specific number of credits to attain their Entry Level and school will provide every opportunity for them to achieve these credits. Assessment is criteria based and not mark based—pupils will provide evidence towards reaching criteria through a range of activities completed in school.
