

Curriculum Pathways - *Nurture*

Nurture is a new pathway, from September 2018. It provides a bespoke curriculum, tailored to the individual needs of a group of pupils whose main barrier to learning is an aspect of Social, Emotional, Mental Health (SEMH).

- The class teacher manages a team of TAs, to facilitate 1:1 supported, highly individualised, timetables.
- Pupils will follow National Curriculum subjects, but specific to individuals. Pupils within this pathway may access teaching from across all the different pathways and year groups that Elms Bank offer.
- Pupils will build up to working with other pupils, as appropriate to individuals.
- Pupils will attend lessons with other classes, as appropriate to individuals.
- The curriculum at KS4 and 5 will focus on gaining employability experience, skills and qualifications for this group of students.
- * Personal Development will be no less than 6 x periods; however to ensure pupils' emotional needs are met, Personal Development could be the whole of the curriculum in the first instance.
