Dear Parent/Carer,

As you will be aware the Government have released their guidance to schools, ready for opening in September. This is a complex document and the return to school will need significant planning. Our senior leaders at school and in the Oak LP Trust are meeting to discuss the document and we will begin the planning process immediately.

At this point we can confirm that we expect the majority of children to return to school, with the only exceptions being those who have received medical advice to stay at home. We are not yet in a position to provide details of how this will be managed in school. We hope to have some level of detailed plan over the next two weeks but I would like to ask you to bear with us.

We do not want to plan something so important in a rushed manner, but we would like to spend time on it to ensure that our plans are as effective and detailed as possible. We need to review everything we do in school and we need to revisit our risk assessments. It is also possible that the government may issue additional guidance over the next few weeks which we will need to take into account.

I am sure that you can appreciate that planning for the return to school in September is a huge job and we want to get it right for our children and their families.

As soon as we have further information we will be in touch again to update you at the earliest possible opportunity.
